



12 Plastic Free Parade Bubble Kits - an infinitely recyclable aluminum jar with bubble concentrate invites you to "add water, gently stir and blow bubbles!" with a wand made from paper tube, gold wire and glass beads. The wands have been made with hundreds of corporate volunteers from Entergy & Ochsner.



12 Biodegradable Glitter Kits - cosmetic glitter in subtle shades of purple, green and gold derived from eucalyptus tree cellulose. The kits come with a jar of shimmery aloe applicator gel and a wooden applicator stick. The kits have been assembled by service day volunteers from McGehee middle and upper school.



10 Coffee Throws - Using beans donated from Westfeldt Coffee to New Orleans Roast, the 2oz medium roast coffee throws bags come stuffed into small burlap throwing bags. Students from the entire Isidore Newman upper school will help "flash assemble" these throws by stickering, stuffing and tying during an assembly period in November 2024.



6 Lemon Sugar Hand Scrub Throws - Sourced from a women owned small business in Raceland, LA these 2.5oz aluminum jars of exfoliating hand scrub are perfect for cleansing hands of oils/odors and are ideal post crawfish boil. Corporate volunteers and service day students from Ben Franklin high school transferred the scrub from large 5 gallon buckets into the small jars that are gift wrapped and boxed for throwing.



5 Herb & Louisiana Wildflower Starter Kits - This throw, underwritten by the Garden Study Club of New Orleans, kits together a peat pot, soil disc, seeds and instructions to grow herbs like, basil and mint, and flowers like Coreopsis (yellow) and Coneflower (purple). Local wildflower seeds are harvested and donated by the Native Plant Initiative who help assemble the throw kits.



1 Jute Fiber Throw Package Tote Bag - made from one of the most sustainable plant materials, this tote bag holds the aforementioned throws for the float ride in 2025
